

## **DKGNA 2020 Testing Season**

As the 2019 DKGNA Testing Season comes to an end the Board of Directors is already hard at work on the 2020 season. First we need to establish what dogs we have that need to be tested, in what tests, and where are they located. Additionally, the Board has been inundated with requests to host tests in 2020. We are very excited about the future and our ability to increase our testing schedule. We need to both serve our members and be financially responsible. To that end the Board is creating a “Criteria for Hosting a DKGNA Test” which will be available by November 1<sup>st</sup>. We will be asking that each individual or group that wishes to host a DKGNA Test in 2020 review and complete the “Criteria” for review by the Board.

The Board will make the decisions on the 2020 tests dates and locations based on the feedback from the members on the number of dogs we have to test, in which tests, their location, which locations can best serve the members, and the host can best serve interest of the members and DKGNA.
